

Tips to Reduce Awkwardness

Awkward sentences usually stem from word choice. Writers sometimes use additional or vague words that do not add any new meaning.

Euphemisms are the substitution of polite or inoffensive terms for those that might be considered too blunt or unpleasant. However, using euphemisms can create a weak style that minimizes the importance of the message. Depending on your goal, choose your vocabulary based on your context and goal.

| Euphemisms | Direct vocabulary |
|---------------------------|-------------------|
| senior citizen | old person |
| artificial stimulants | alcohol and drugs |
| neutralize | assassinate |
| previously owned vehicles | used cars |

Some cliche expressions, phrases, or unnecessary words may actually impede the flow.

| Wordy | Not as wordy |
|------------------------|--------------|
| at this point in time | now |
| subsequent to | after |
| a majority of | most |
| due to the fact that | because |
| in the neighborhood of | about |

Wordy sentences stray the reader away from the main idea. As you write, choose strong verbs and identify the doer of the action.

Wordy: It is important to notice that the main primary reason for which the school curriculum does not align with students' needs is the focus on test achievement rather than the learning of skills.

Concise: The primary reason the school curriculum doesn't align with students needs is the emphasis on test achievement over skill development.

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
